



Paper Doll Wall Hanging

Finishes to approx 28" x 44"

Fabric Requirements:

1 /2 yard doll fabric

1/ 2 yard fabric for sashing and binding

1 /2 yard outer border

For the dolls:

Cut a plastic template 4 1/4" x 9 1/2". Use this template to draw the fussy cutting line around the dolls on the back of the fabric. Draw your cutting line around all the dolls before you begin cutting. Some of them have a very small distance between them and you may need to adjust for that. Cut 9 dolls. Using the remaining fabric, fussy cut (4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" flower motifs for the four cornerstones in the sashing.

For the sashing:

Cut 5 strips 2 1/2" wide by the width of fabric. Cut these strips into:

- (6) 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles for the vertical sashing
- (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/4" rectangles for the horizontal sashing
- (2) 2 1/2" x 15 3/4" rectangles for the top and bottom sash border
- (2) 2 1/2" x 35 1/2" rectangle for the left and right side sash border

Save the leftover strips for binding

For the border:

Cut (4) strips 4 1/2" x the width of the fabric. Cut these strips into:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 35" rectangles for the left and right side outer border
- (2) 1 1/2" x 28 3/4" rectangles for the top and bottom outer border

Refer to the diagram above. Using a 1/4" seam, sew the dolls between 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" vertical sashing strips to make rows. Sew the horizontal strips to the sides of the fussy cut cornerstone blocks. Press your seams toward the cornerstone blocks. Sew the paper doll rows between those strips, pressing your seams away from the cornerstone blocks. This will help your seams line up exactly. Press.

Add the borders, matching the center of the border with the center of the quilt top and easing to fit. Forcing the quilt top to match two identically cut borders will force it to lay flat. Press toward the borders. Quilt as desired.
