

# Teeny Tiny Mystery

## Two

Here is another Teeny Tiny Mystery! This one finishes about 21" x 21". All measurements assume a perfect 1/4" seam allowance.

### Fabric Requirements:

- Color 1 (bright) : (1) 5" x 5" Square
- Color 2 (medium) : (4) 2 1/2" x 7" Rectangles
- Color 3 (light) : (4) 2 1/2" x 11" Rectangles
- Color 4 (dark) : (4) 3 1/2" x 17 1/2" Rectangles and  
(2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Rectangles and  
(1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Rectangle.

### Step One

Sew a Color 2 Medium 2 1/2" x 7" rectangle strip to one side of the Color 1 Bright 5" x 5" Square, stopping about an inch from the edge. It will hang loosely, but don't worry. (Figure 1) Press to the rectangle strip.

Working counterclockwise, sew another Color 2 Medium 2 1/2" x 7" rectangle strip to the unit you just made. (Figure 2) Press to the rectangle strip.

Continue sewing Color 2 Medium 2 1/2" x 7" Rectangles around the center block this way until you come to the end. (Figure 3 and 4) Finish sewing that partial seam from Strip 1 to Strip 4. Press and square up to 9" x 9" if necessary.

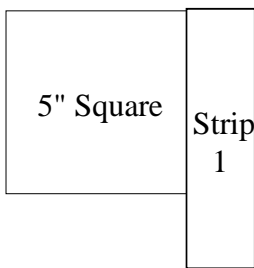

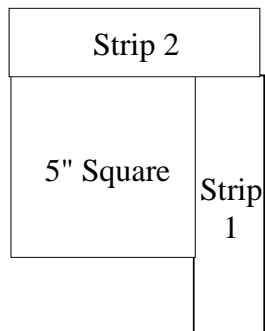

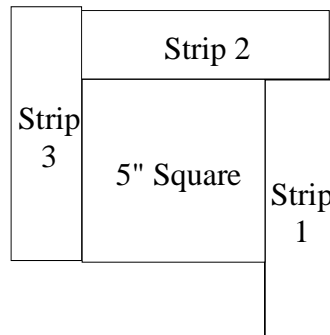
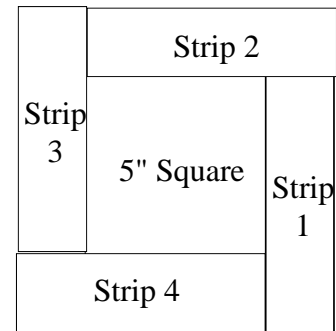

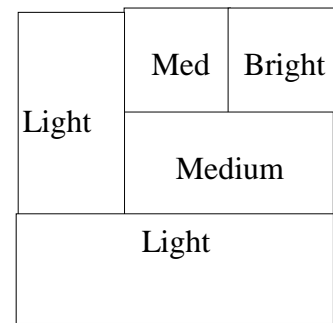


### Step Two

Using the same method with the (4) Color 3 Light 2 1/2" x 11" rectangles, add another round of rectangle strips to your block. It will look the same as Figure 4 block above with an additional row of strips around it. Press to the strips and square up your block to 13".

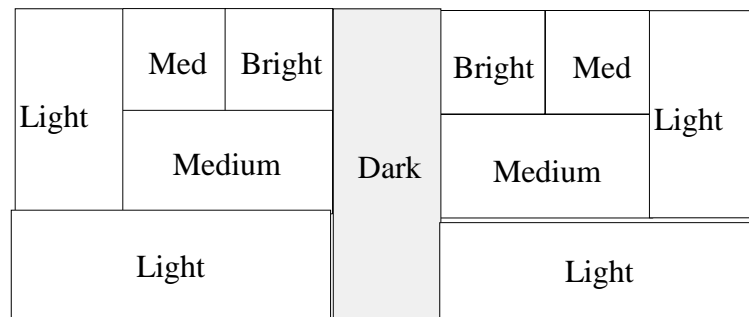
### Step Three

Cut the block you just made through the center both horizontally and vertically to make (4) 6 ½" x 6 ½" blocks like the one to the right. Press and square up to 6 ½" x 6 ½" if necessary.



### Step Four

Sew (2) Step Three units to either side of a 2 ½" x 6 ½" dark rectangle, placing the bright square in the inside edge where it meets the dark rectangle as shown below. Make (2) of these. Press to the dark.



### Step Five

Sew the (2) Step Four units to either side of (1) Color 4 dark 2 ½" x 14 ½" Rectangle, keeping the bright corner block in the center. Press to the dark.

### Step Six

Using the same partial seam piecing technique you used in Step One, sew the Color 4 dark (4) 3 ½" x 17 ½" rectangles around the block you just made. This is the border. Press to the dark.

You are done! Batt, back, quilt and enjoy.
